Project SANDI: helping individuals to jump-start their careers

Nevada is 1 of 8 States to be awarded the Supporting and Advancing Nevada's Dislocated Individuals (SANDI) project from the U.S. Department of Education.

This investment toward expanding short-term education and training opportunities increases Nevadans access to career pathways in Nevada's priority sectors including healthcare, advanced manufacturing, logistics, information technology (IT) and skilled trades to meet the needs of students, employers, and their local community. Project SANDI has supported more than 500 Nevadans from across the State in partnership with Great Basin College, College of Southern Nevada, Truckee Meadows Community College, Western Nevada College and other training providers.

There is still funding left to support 1,200 more Nevadans over the next year who have been adversely affected by the pandemic and are looking to jumpstart their careers.
