DETR Releases Local Area Employment Statistics for August 2026

According to the Nevada Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation's ([DETR](#)) August 2026 economic report, the state's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.8 percent in August 2026 which decreased by 0.2 percentage points (pp) from July. Seasonally adjusted estimates account for regularly seen economic patterns, with the following estimates not seasonally adjusted.

In the three Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSA), the unemployment rates were 4.8 percent in the Las Vegas area, 3.5 percent in Reno, and 3.4 percent in the Carson area in August 2026.

In Nevada's counties, the lowest unemployment rate was observed in Elko County at 2.8 percent, while Mineral County had the highest rate at 7 percent. For a look at the unemployment rate in your county, visit our [Area Profiles Page](#).

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ABOUT THE RESEARCH AND ANALYSIS BUREAU:

The [Research and Analysis Bureau](#) is Nevada's premier source for labor market information. A part of DETR, the Bureau is responsible for creating, analyzing, and reporting Nevada's labor market information, in cooperation with the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS).

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In August 2026, the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in Nevada decreased by 0.2 percentage points (pp) compared to July 2026 and currently stands at 4.8 percent. Over the same period, the unadjusted unemployment rate decreased by 0.6 pp, from 5.1 percent to 4.5 percent.

At the MSA (Metropolitan Statistical Area) level, unemployment rates decreased across all Nevada MSAs compared to July 2026. In the Las Vegas-Henderson-North Las Vegas MSA, the unemployment rate decreased by 0.6 pp, moving from 5.4 percent in July to 4.8 percent. The Reno-Sparks MSA unemployment rate decreased by 0.5 pp, moving from 4 percent in July to 3.5 percent. Meanwhile, the Carson City MSA unemployment rate decreased by 0.5 pp, moving from 3.9 percent in July to 3.4 percent. These figures are not seasonally adjusted.

At the county level, all of Nevada's 17 counties experienced a decrease in unemployment rates compared to July 2026. The counties with the largest decreases were Mineral (-1.2 pp), followed by Esmeralda (-1.1 pp).

Figures for state unemployment estimates come from the Local Area Unemployment Statistics (LAUS) program, a state/federal partnership sponsored by the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS-LAUS). This program produces monthly and annual employment, unemployment, and labor force data for census regions, states, counties, metropolitan areas, and many large cities, based on place of residence. 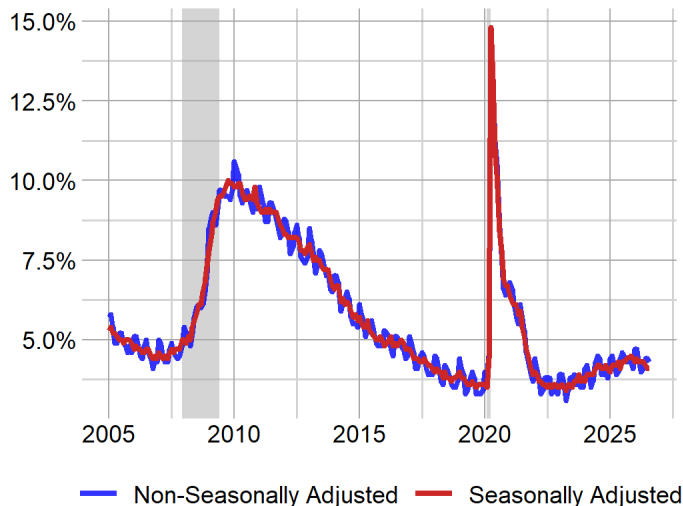

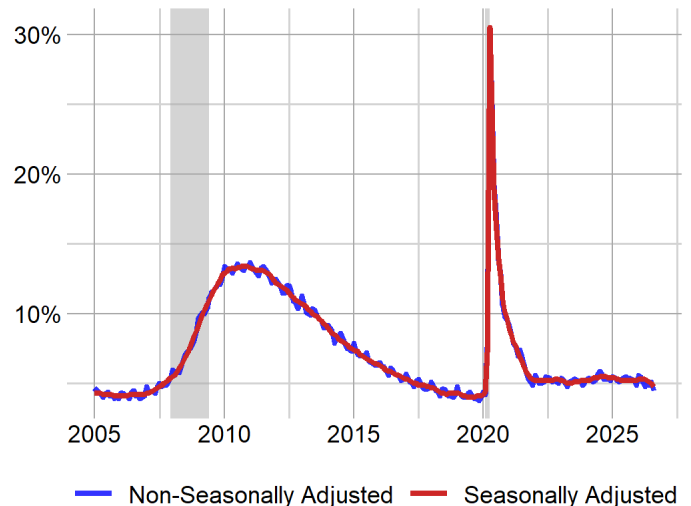
Seasonally adjusted estimates account for regularly seen seasonal employment patterns such as jobs associated with holiday hiring, holiday and weather seasons, or other jobs with seasonal components. The result of a seasonally adjusted estimate is usually a smoother estimate from which underlying economic trends can be seen. Adjusted estimates are in the summary table above, and in many of the other tables and figures throughout this document.

Nevada's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.8 percent in August, down 0.2 pp from 5 percent in July, and down 0.4 pp from 5.2 percent in August 2025. The number of unemployed individuals decreased by 3,231 from July for a current level of 81,130 people, which decreased by 6,269 since August 2025. The labor force in Nevada is currently composed of 1,675,646 people, which has decreased by 5,951 since July, and increased by 4,409 since August 2025.

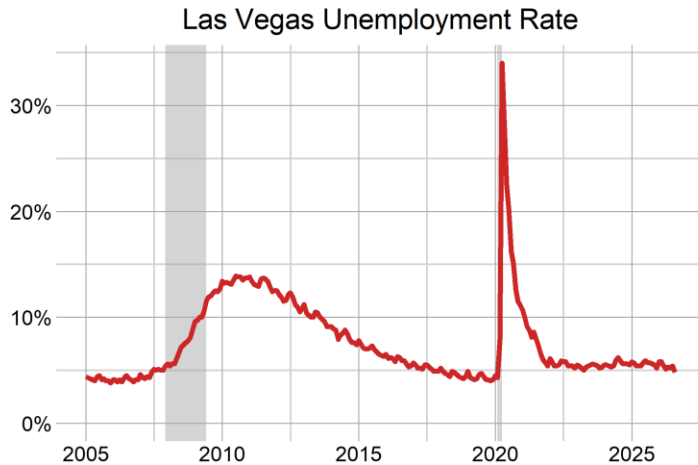
United States Unemployment Rate



Nevada Unemployment Rate

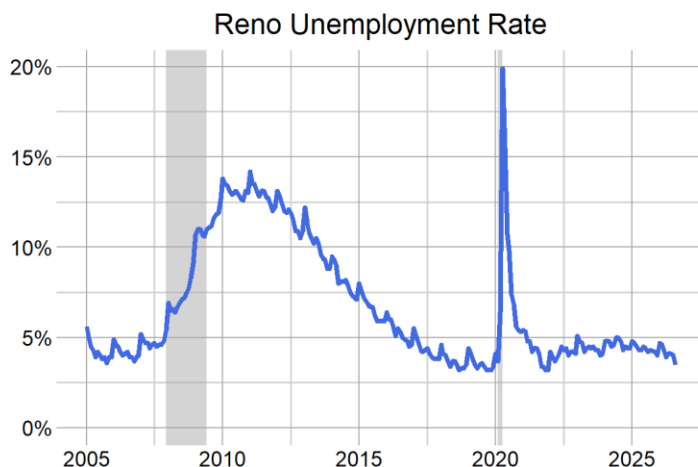


The Las Vegas Metropolitan Statistical Area's (MSA) unemployment rate was 4.8 percent in August 2026, down 0.6 pp from 5.4 percent in July, and down 0.9 pp from 5.7 percent in August 2025, not seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals decreased by 7,702 since July for a current level of 59,489 people, which is 11,239 fewer than in August 2025. The labor force in Las Vegas is currently composed of 1,229,087 people, which is 10,996 fewer than in July, and 4,386 fewer than in August 2025.



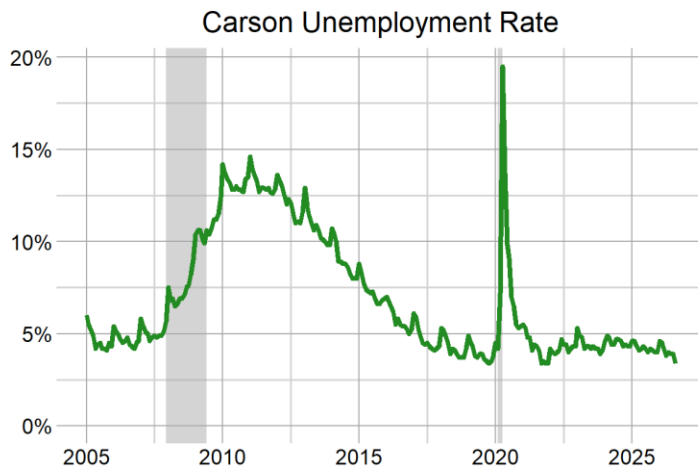

The Reno MSA's unemployment rate was 3.5 percent in August 2026, down 0.5 pp from 4 percent in July, and down 0.7 pp from 4.2 percent in August 2025, non-seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals decreased by 1,668 since July for a current level of 10,355 people, which is 2,289 fewer than in August 2025. The labor force in Reno is currently composed of 296,490 people, which is 3,607 fewer than in July, and 2,326 fewer than in August 2025.

The Carson City MSA's unemployment rate was 3.4 percent in August, down 0.5 pp from 3.9 percent in July, and down 0.6 pp from 4 percent in August 2025, not seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals decreased by 173 since July for a current level of 968 people, which is 225 fewer than in August 2025. The labor force in Carson City is currently composed of 28,892 people, which is 586 fewer than in July, and 621 fewer than in August 2025.

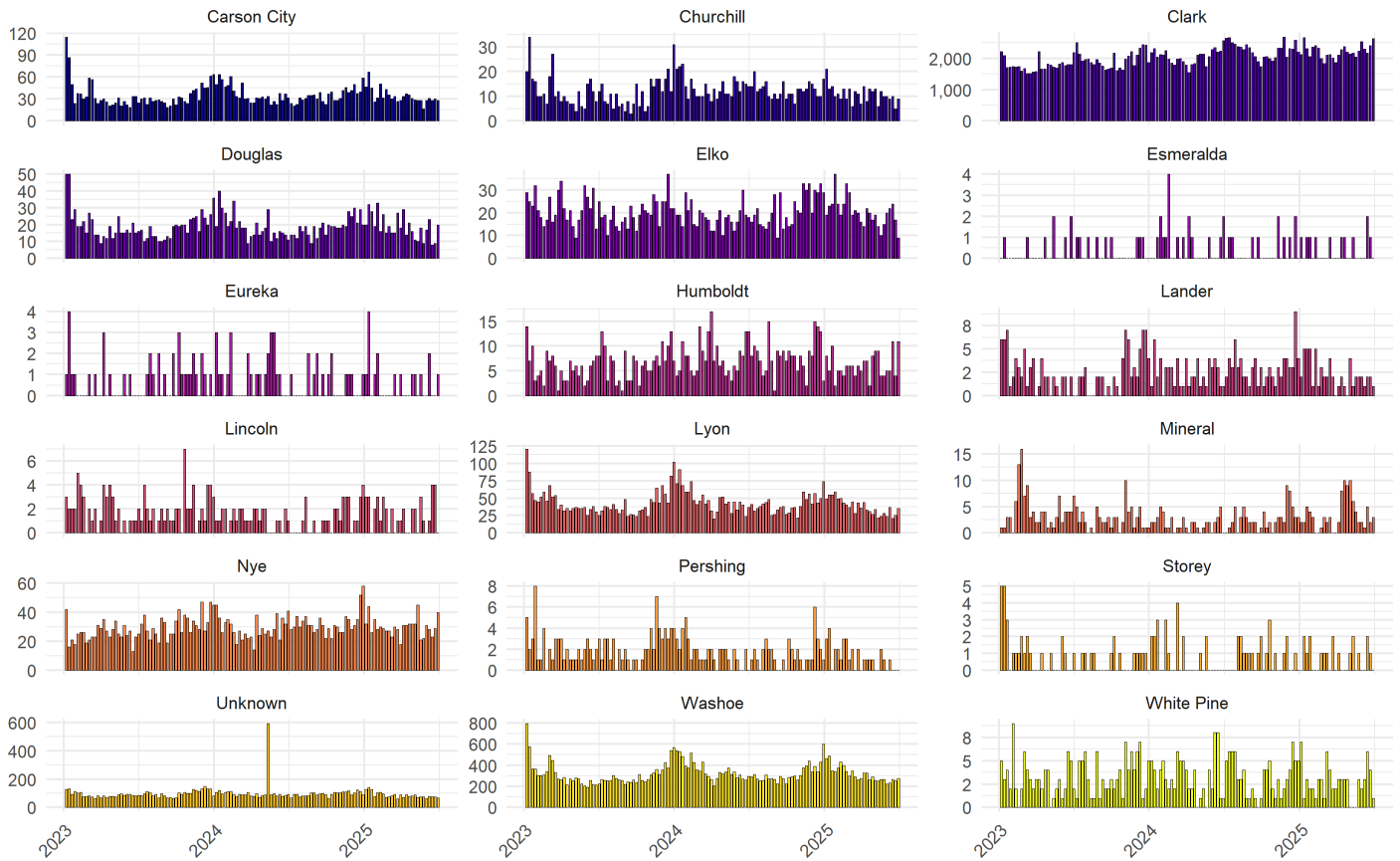
Unemployment Insurance Benefits

In August 2026, 11,492 initial claims for unemployment insurance were filed in Nevada, representing a decrease of 474 claims, or -4 percent, from July 2026 when there were 11,966 claims. However, this is a decrease of 404 claims, or -3.4 percent, from August 2025 when there were 11,896 initial claims.

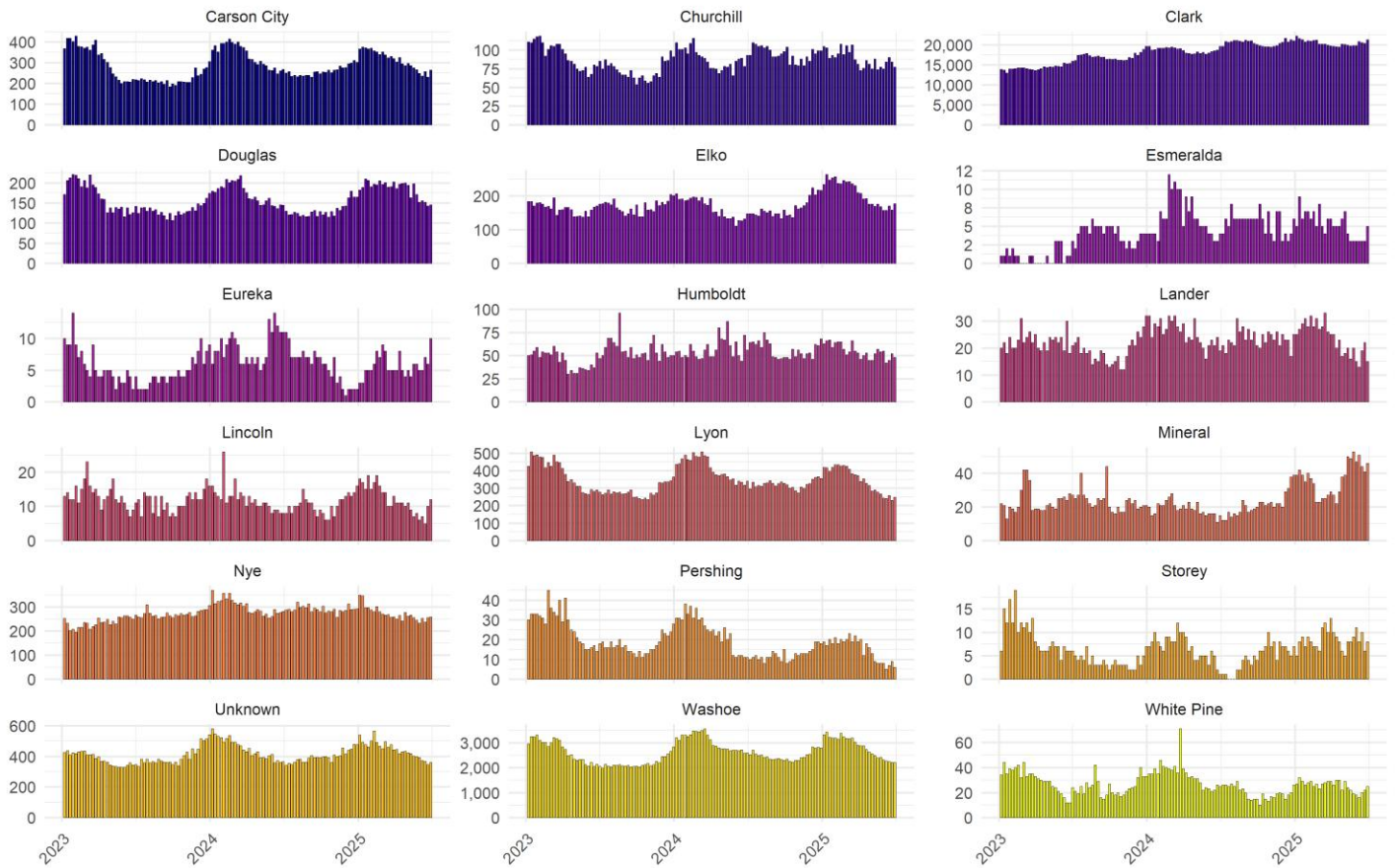
