EmployNV Hubs in the north are facilitated via a partnership between DETR and Nevadaworks, the workforce development board for northern Nevada administering federal funds associated with the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act.

Through its workforce partnership between DETR and Nevadaworks, the new EmployNV location offers Nevada businesses and career seekers expanded access to professional workforce support, training resources, and employer services, all free of charge. EmployNV provides no-cost services including job search assistance, skills training resources, employer support, and career counseling.

“This new hub reflects our commitment to ensuring every Nevadan has access to the tools, training, and support they need to succeed,” said Christopher Sewell, Director of the Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation (DETR). “We are grateful for the collaboration of our community partners and excited to expand services to the Fernley region.”
