EmployNV's Operation Silverbridge to Host its Inaugural Veteran Resource Expo in Las Vegas

LAS VEGAS — EmployNV will host its inaugural veteran resource connection event Thursday, Feb. 5, in Las Vegas.

“Operation Silverbridge,” a Veterans Resource Expo will connect transitioning military service members, veterans, military spouses and dependents, to local programs, pre-employment services and provide tools for improving quality of life.

The event will be from **10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at Sahara West Library, 9600 W. Sahara Ave., Las Vegas, NV 89117.**

More than 25 resources and nonprofits will be on site, including the Charlie Mike Foundation, Mobile Vet Center, AUSA and others.

Available services include education and training, disability claims, VSO assistance, legal services, trusted peer groups, mental health support, education and training and emergency services.

“It’s great to see initiatives like Operation Silverbridge that aim to bridge the gap between military and civilian job markets. Veterans provide a vast array of skills honed through their service, including leadership, teamwork, problem-solving, and specialized technical expertise.” said, Monica Roberts USAF Veteran.
