DETR Releases Local Area Employment Statistics for June 2026

According to the Nevada Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation's ([DETR](#)) June 2026 economic report, the state's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 5.1 percent in June 2026 which decreased by 0.1 percentage points (pp) from May. Seasonally adjusted estimates account for regularly seen economic patterns, with the following estimates not seasonally adjusted.

In the three Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSA), the unemployment rates were 5.2 percent in the Las Vegas area, 4.1 percent in Reno, and 3.9 percent in the Carson area in June 2026.

In Nevada's counties, the lowest unemployment rate was observed in Elko County at 3.5 percent, while Mineral County had the highest rate at 8.7 percent. For a look at the unemployment rate in your county, visit our [Area Profiles Page](#).

In June 2026, the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in Nevada decreased by 0.1 percentage points (pp) compared to May 2026 and currently stands at 5.1 percent. Over the same period, the unadjusted unemployment rate decreased by 0.1 pp, from 5 percent to 4.9 percent.

At the MSA (Metropolitan Statistical Area) level, unemployment rates decreased across two Nevada MSAs compared to May 2026. In the Las Vegas-Henderson-North Las Vegas MSA, the unemployment rate decreased by 0.1 pp, moving from 5.3 percent in May to 5.2 percent. The Reno-Sparks MSA unemployment rate remained steady at 4.1 percent. Meanwhile, the Carson City MSA unemployment rate decreased by 0.1 pp, moving from 4 percent in May to 3.9 percent. These figures are not seasonally adjusted.

At the county level, the majority of Nevada's 17 counties (13 out of 17) experienced a decrease in unemployment rates compared to May 2026. The counties with the largest decreases were Mineral (-0.3 pp), followed by Douglas, Lander, Lincoln, White Pine, and Storey (-0.2 pp).

Figures for state unemployment estimates come from the Local Area Unemployment Statistics (LAUS) program, a state/federal partnership sponsored by the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS-LAUS). This program produces monthly and annual employment, unemployment, and labor force data for census regions, states, counties, metropolitan areas, and many large cities, based on place of residence. 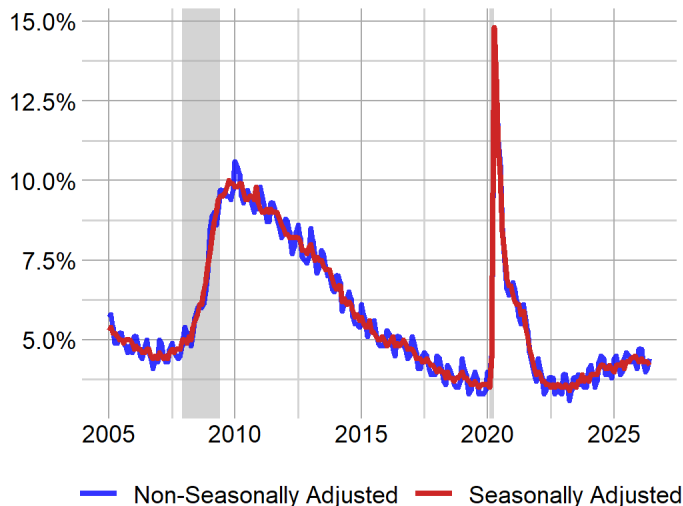

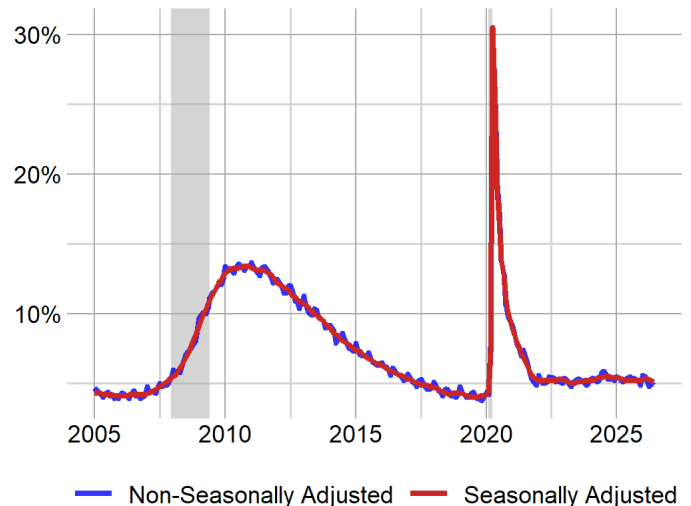
Seasonally adjusted estimates account for regularly seen seasonal employment patterns such as jobs associated with holiday hiring, holiday and weather seasons, or other jobs with seasonal components. The result of a seasonally adjusted estimate is usually a smoother estimate from which underlying economic trends can be seen. Adjusted estimates are in the summary table above, and in many of the other tables and figures throughout this document.

Nevada's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 5.1 percent in June, down 0.1 pp from 5.2 percent in May, and down 0.1 pp from 5.2 percent in June 2025. The number of unemployed individuals decreased by 2,143 from May for a current level of 86,472 people, which decreased by 430 since June 2025. The labor force in Nevada is currently composed of 1,686,765 people, which has decreased by 6,845 since May, and increased by 24,658 since June 2025.

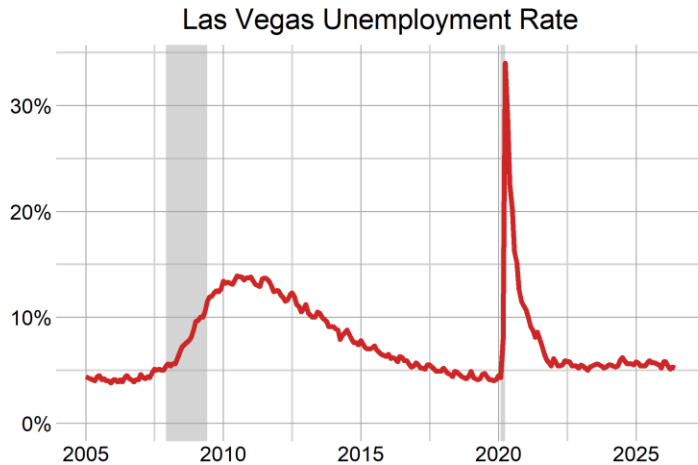
United States Unemployment Rate



Nevada Unemployment Rate

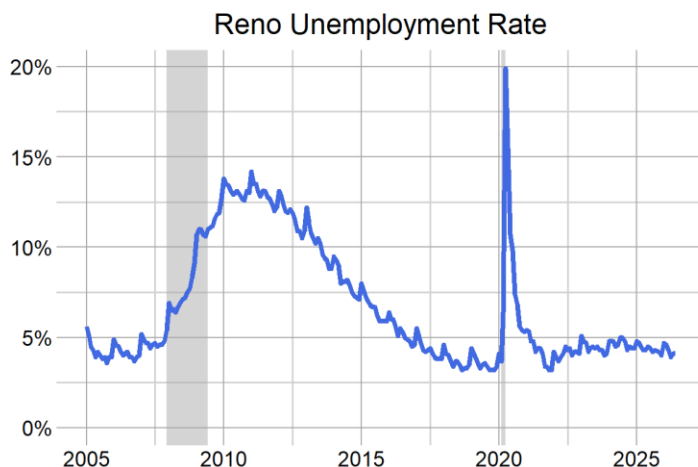


The Las Vegas Metropolitan Statistical Area's (MSA) unemployment rate was 5.2 percent in June 2026, down 0.1 pp from 5.3 percent in May, and down 0.5 pp from 5.7 percent in June 2025, not seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals decreased by 2,401 since May for a current level of 64,070 people, which is 5,461 fewer than in June 2025. The labor force in Las Vegas is currently composed of 1,231,702 people, which is 13,276 fewer than in May, and 3,715 more than in June 2025.

The Reno MSA's unemployment rate was 4.1 percent in June 2026, unchanged from 4.1 percent in May, and down 0.4 pp from 4.5 percent in June 2025, non-seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals decreased by 428 since May for a current level of 12,176 people, which is 1,417 fewer than in June 2025. The labor force in Reno is currently composed of 300,003 people, which is 4,455 fewer than in May, and 2,003 fewer than in June 2025.

The Carson City MSA’s unemployment rate was 3.9 percent in June, down 0.1 pp from 4 percent in May, and down 0.4 pp from 4.3 percent in June 2025, not seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals decreased by 32 since May for a current level of 1,157 people, which is 125 fewer than in June 2025. The labor force in Carson City is currently composed of 29,429 people, which is 322 fewer than in May, and 693 fewer than in June 2025.

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Unemployment Insurance Benefits

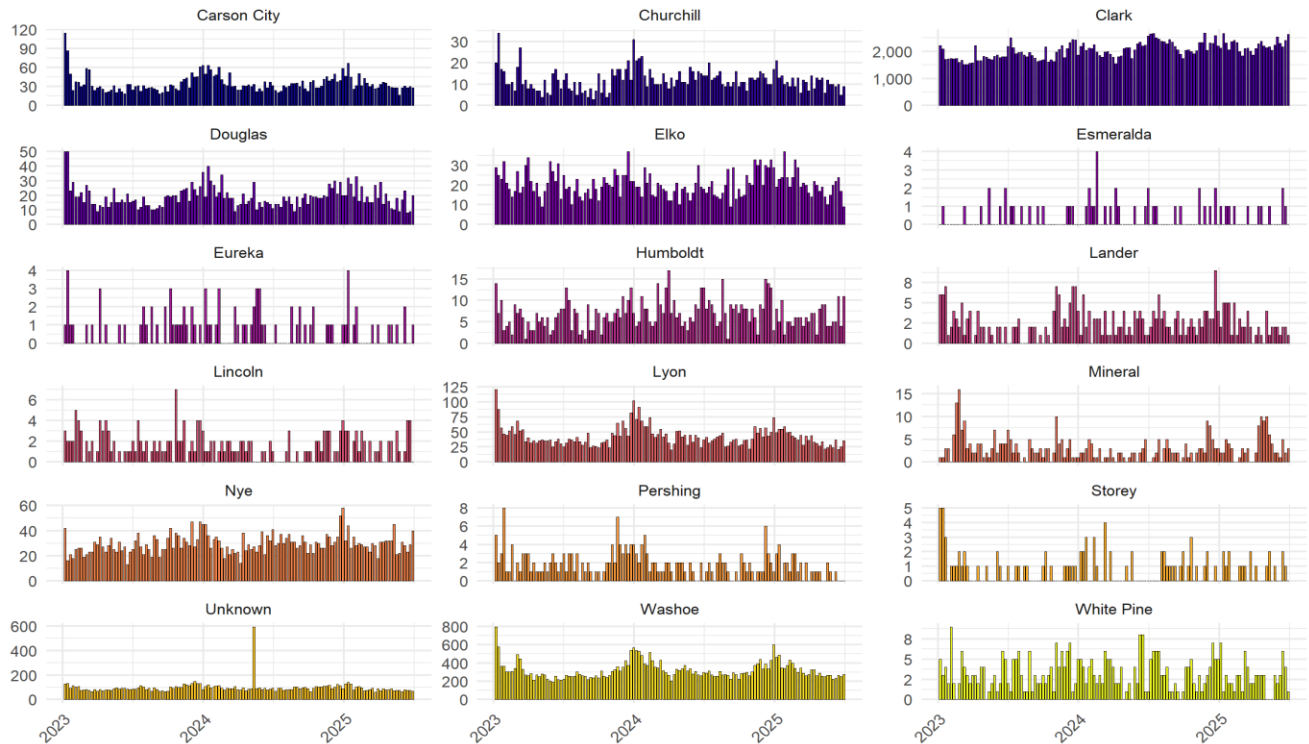
In June 2026, 11,695 initial claims for unemployment insurance were filed in Nevada, representing an increase of 924 claims, or 8.6 percent, from May 2026 when there were 10,771 claims. However, this is an increase of 66 claims, or 0.6 percent, from June 2025 when there were 11,629 initial claims.

weekly claim totals since January 2023



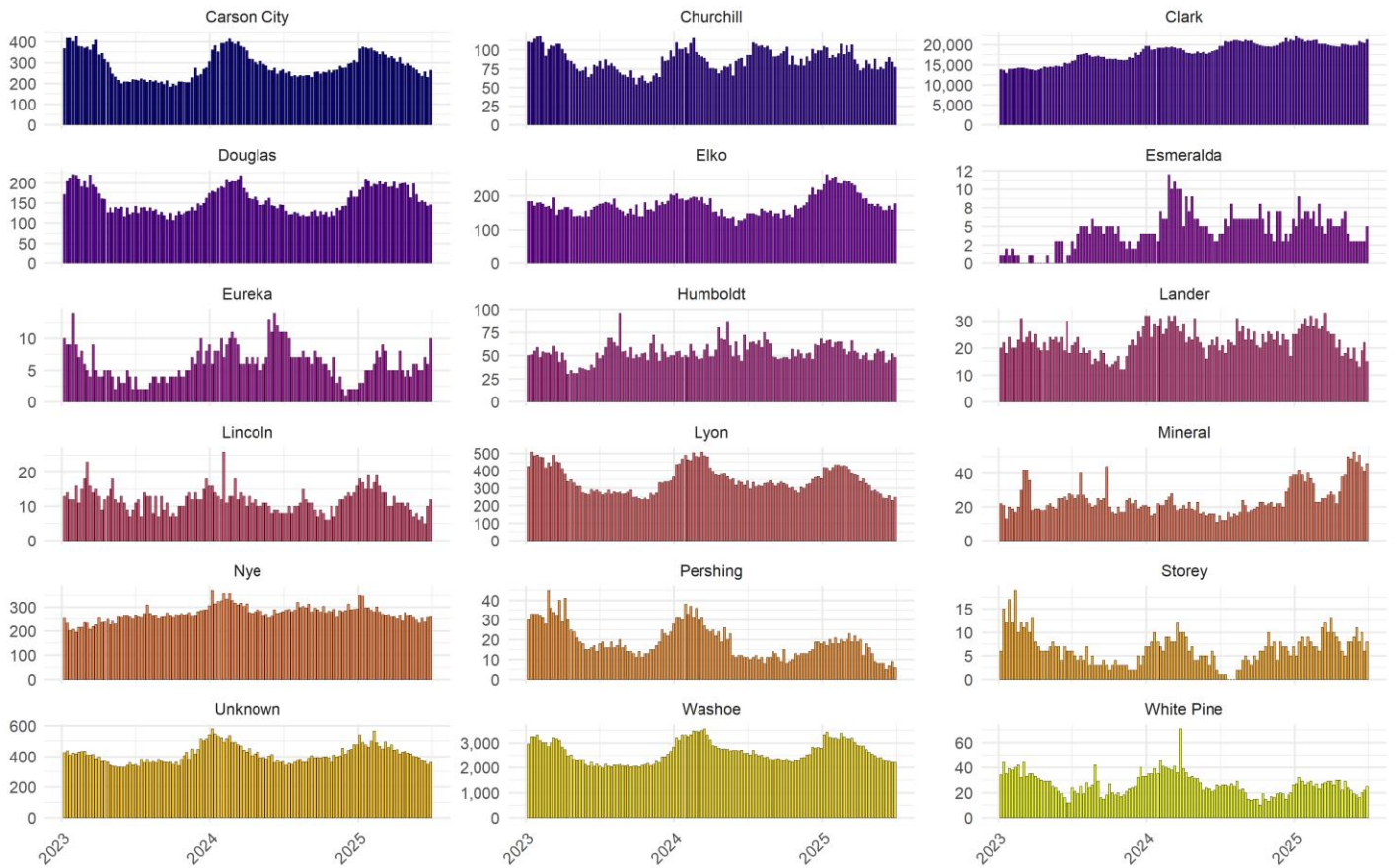
