Re: Notice Pursuant to Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act

Dear Chairman Naft:

This letter shall serve as notice pursuant to the Worker Adjustment Notification and Retaining Act of 1988, 29 U.S.C. § 2100, et. seq. Please be advised that Wynn Las Vegas, LLC and Wynn Show Performers, LLC (collectively referred to as "the Company") are closing their production of *Awakening* at Wynn Las Vegas ("the Show"), located at 3131 Las Vegas Boulevard South, Las Vegas, Nevada 89109.

The Company has made the difficult decision to close *Awakening* following the final performance on October 10, 2026. This decision was not made lightly. We are immensely proud of what the *Awakening* company created together and deeply grateful for the dedication, professionalism, and many contributions they have made to the production and to Wynn Las Vegas throughout its run.

With respect to this Notice, we are providing the following information:

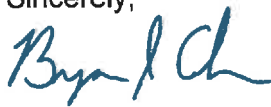
1. The Show will close to the public on October 10, 2026.
2. The expected date of the first employment separation related to the Show's closure is expected to occur on October 21, 2026.
3. The closure of the Show is permanent.
4. The affected employees are not represented by a union.
5. No bumping rights exist.
